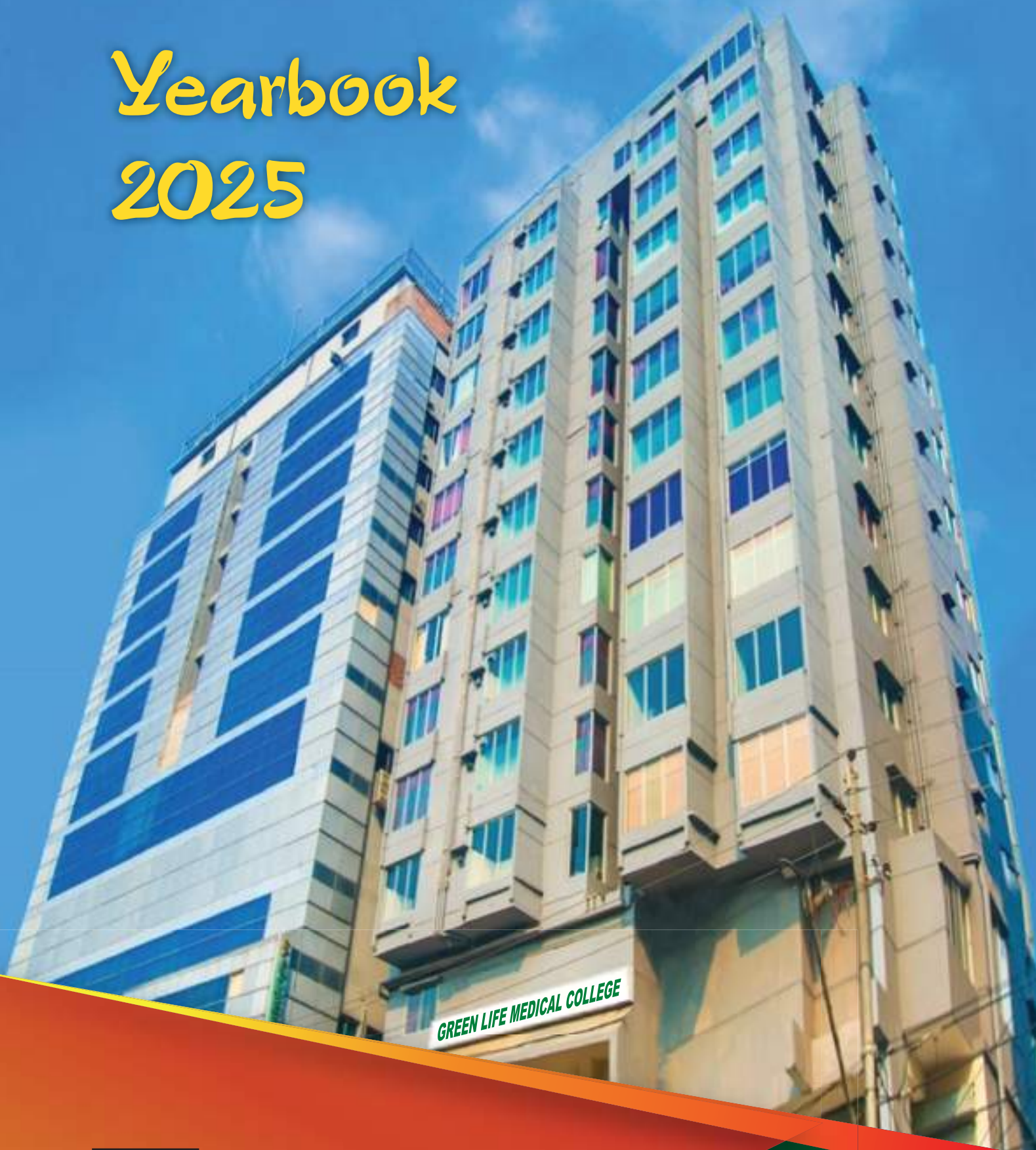

Brief History **of** **Green Life Medical College**

Green Life Medical College (GLMC) is a prestigious private medical institution providing high-quality medical education in Bangladesh. It was established in 2009 with the mission of serving humanity through academic excellence and ethical practice. The academic journey began in 2010 with the admission of 51 students in the inaugural batch. Over the years, the institution has expanded steadily and currently enrolls 120 students annually, including a portion of seats reserved for international students. Today, GLMC has evolved into a dynamic center for medical education, clinical training and professional development.

Vision

Green Life Medical College aspires to be a nationally and internationally recognized center of excellence in medical education, research and healthcare delivery in Bangladesh and beyond. The institution is committed to producing competent, ethical and globally responsive physicians while ensuring accessible, affordable and equitable healthcare through continuous quality improvement and innovation.

Mission

“Together Towards Excellence in Medical Education”

Green Life Medical College is dedicated to maintaining high academic standards and strong ethical values through competency-based and community-oriented medical education aligned with the Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council and the Directorate General of Medical Education.

The College emphasizes structured clinical training, research addressing community health priorities, social accountability and continuous faculty development. It aims to produce graduates who will be skilled, compassionate and professionally responsible physicians committed to serve the society.

Affiliations and Recognitions

Green Life Medical College is approved by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MHFW) and its degree is recognized by the Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council (BMDC). The college is academically affiliated with the University of Dhaka, with postgraduate training accredited by the Bangladesh College of Physicians and Surgeons (BCPS).

GLMC is also listed in the World Directory of Medical Schools, the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG), the Avicenna Directory, the World Federation for Medical Education (WFME), and the Foundation for Advancement of International Medical Education and Research (FAIMER).

Academic Building and Infrastructure:

Green Life Medical College is equipped with modern infrastructure to support high-quality medical education and healthcare services. The institution has a 16-storied academic building (159,111.18 square feet), along with an extension academic building (59,372.136 square feet). The academic facilities include spacious lecture galleries, demonstration rooms, tutorial classrooms, skill laboratories, examination halls and museums, providing a comprehensive teaching–learning environment for undergraduate medical education.

All departments are equipped with high-speed internet connectivity and webcam facilities to support digital learning platforms, virtual classrooms, academic meetings and other technology-enabled educational activities as needed.

The college is supported by Green Life Hospital (297,115.164 square feet), established in 2005 with an initial capacity of 500 beds, later expanded to 600 beds, and a 100-bed extension building is currently under construction, aiming to increase the total bed capacity to 700. Additionally, the college owns 200 decimals of land in Purbachal New City, reserved for future institutional expansion and infrastructure development.

Library and Hostel Facilities

Green Life Medical College has a well-equipped library with 120 seats, and an additional 150-seat reading area under construction. The college also has a digital library with access to HINARI (WHO research database) and approximately 300 e-books, along with a wide collection of national and international journals, all accessible via the institutional internet network.

The college also offers residential facilities with two boys 'hostels and one girls' hostel for safe student accommodation.

Academic Faculty Members:

Green Life Medical College has 141 dedicated full-time faculty members committed to excellence in teaching, research and mentorship. The faculty is led by National Professor Dr. Shahla Khatun, Chairman and Professor Dr. A.B.M. Bayezid Hossain, Principal.

Under their visionary leadership, along with the expertise of the faculty members, the college ensures a strong academic foundation and fosters an environment of innovation and learning. Together, they provide excellence in education and prepare students to succeed in the field of medicine.
