



Professional MBBS Examinations are held twice a year, in May and November. Prerequisites for appearing for the University Examinations are stated below:

For Each Professional MBBS Examination:

A candidate must have:

- ➤ Attended at least 75% classes in each subjects.
- ➤ Obtained pass marks (minimum 60% of the total) in all formative examinations.
- Certificate of good conduct from the concerned departments.
- > Paid University registration and exam fees.
- > Paid all College dues such as tuition fees etc.
- Passed all subjects in previous Professional MBBS Examination (For 2nd, 3rd and Final Professional Examination).
- ➤ After passing MBBS, One year internship training is mandatory.

The Carry on System:

➤ A student who becomes eligible to appear in Professional Examination will enroll in next year's classes 10-14 days after completion of Examination.

Online Class:

During the COVID 19 Pandemic and nation wide Lock down, under the guidance of The Chairman, Governing Body, Professor Shahla Khatun, a special Online Class Committee was created in early March of 2021. The committee worked hard and sincerely in order to initiate and conduct online classes and examinations, and Green Life Medical College was one of the institutes that started online academic activities in earliest time. To achieve this, the committee effortlessly worked to train the teachers, students and staffs, arrange new routines, create class moderators, buy zoom account and to communicate with the students at home and abroad. The committee also arranged several virtual meetings between faculties, CME on COVID 19. The activities of the committee continued till August, when physical classes again started to resume.



Internship Training:

After obtaining the MBBS degree, the student must complete one year internship at Green Life Medical College and Hospital (GMCH) including two week community placement in a Upazilla Health Complex which are pre-requisites for obtaining Permanent Registration from the Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council (BMDC).

The training is specifically designed to develop necessary skills and attitudes to deal with common health problems as well as the difficult ones by working in the hospital and in the rural settings.









Medical Education Unit and Skill Centre

- Continuous Medical Educations (CMEs), CPDs, Seminars, and Symposiums are held regularly under the supervision of Medical Education Unit of GMC.
- Weekly CME: Interns & trainee Doctors and all teachers sessions are held through-out the year. In CME, presentations from all the departments of college and Medical Eduction Unit take place. Eminent speakers and scientists of the country also deliver keynote speeches.
- Skill Centre of GMC is equipped with several dummy, viscera, specimen, surgical instruments, suture materials etc through which students and Intern Doctors can enhance their skills by practicing.
- Departments of Medicine, Surgery, Obstetrics and Gynaecology held regular "Basic Skill Training" for the intern Doctors. All the Internees have to complete the training in the subjects before completion of their internship.

Green Life Medical College Journal

A scientific journal, is regularly being published from the College. It is a bi-annual publication. The Journal publishes Original Article, Review Article, Case Report, Case Series and Editorial.



Residential Field Site Training and Day Visits

During RFST, the students are placed in rural primary health care centre for two weeks during their third year course. Upazilla Health and Family Planning Officer and Resident Medical Officer of Upazilla Health Complex act as adjunct faculty during the placement.

The students also visit eight to ten important health facilities in and around Dhaka city as a part of day visits and Study Tour programme.







Library

The College Library is in the level 13 of the academic section. It is a spacious hall, well and adequately furnished having a cool and silent atmosphere favourable for study. The Library is enriched with a wide collection of text and reference books as well as medical journals to provide current information to the students. It has an easy access system and remains open on all working days from 8.00 am to 8.00 pm.






Virtual and Digital Library

Admission Process

Director General of Health Services (DGHS), Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh conducts a central written admission test at the national level for admission in the government and non-government Medical Colleges each year. They publish a merit list for eligible candidates. The authority of Green Life Medical College selects the students as per rules laid down by the DGHS and MoHFW.

The selected candidates will be examined by a medical board for physical fitness. The medical board will be formed by the Principal of Green Life Medical College.

Admission, Tuition and Incidental Fee submission

All payments are to be made in full at the time of admission. All payments made at the time of admission are non-refundable.

- Tuition fee is payable on monthly basis within the first week of each month.
- Failure of payment on the due date will result in a fine on a daily basis.
- If monthly fees are delayed by more than one month, student's name will be removed from the attendance register.
- The name of the student will be removed from the College Register if tuition fees are not paid for two months consecutively. In such case, the student has to pay re-admission fees to get re-enrollment.

Tuition fees Taka 8,000/- (Taka Eight Thousand only) per month

Internship remuneration: as per instruction of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare

visits to various health centre expense, Forensic Medicine Autopsy expense at Government morgue, Caution money, University student's registration fee, University, BMDC and Ministry annual affiliation

renewal fee, Cultural programme and Sports etc.

- * Accommodation and food charges to be paid seperately.
- * The fee structure can be changed anytime as per the order of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare.

Distribution of Seats

1. General quota:

Forty Eight Percent (48%) seats are available for the Bangladeshi candidates who can get admission according to the merit score of Medical Admission Test published by DGHS, MOHFW.

2. Freedom Fighter:

Two percent (2%) seats will be available for wards of freedom fighters. For these seats, attested photocopy of appropriate documents should be submitted along with the admission form.

3. Poor and Meritorious:

Five percent (5%) seats will be available for the poor and meritorious category.

4. Foreign Students:

Forty-five percent (45%) seats are available for overseas students according to MOHFW mandate.

Documents to be submitted by the Candidates

For admission to MBBS course to this medical college, the students will apply in the prescribed form (to be collected from the Principal's office with payment). The completed form along with the following documents should be submitted during admission.

- Original and photocopies of SSC or equivalent certificate, mark sheet/academic transcript.
- Original and photocopies of HSC or equivalent certificate, mark sheet/academic transcript and testimonial.
- Four recent colour passport size attested photographs (1.6" x 2").
- Photocopy of MBBS admission examination admit card and result (website copy).
- Money receipt of application form.



Criteria for Admission of Foreign Students in The Non-government Medical Colleges in Bangladesh for 2021-2022 Academic Year Under Self-finance Scheme:

1. Equivalence of Foreign Degree:

- Must have passed qualifying examinations (HSC/'A' level) or equivalent examination.
- SSC/'0' level or equivalent examination be passed preceding 3 years of HSC/A level or equivalent.
- HSC/A' level or equivalent examination be passed in 2021/2020.
- Minimum aggregate GPA in SSC /'O' level or equivalent and HSC/'A' level or equivalent examination: 8.00 (eight].
- Minimum GPA in SSC /'O' level or equivalent or in HSC/'A" level and equivalent examination :3.5.
- Minimum GPA in Biology.: 3.5.
- For calculation of GPA against the marks obtained in SSC/ '0' level or equivalent exam, only top. 5 subjects are considered. Therefore, GPA in 'O' level (total marks obtained in top five subjects)/5.
- Optional subject shall be considered if GPA is below 5 (five).
- For calculation of GPA against the marks obtained in HSC/ 'A' level or equivalent exam, only 3 subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) are considered. Qualifying Grade in each subject individually is "C". Therefore, GPA in'A' level= (total marks obtained in three subjects)/3.

2. Application Form:

Duly filled application forms in triplicate along with following documents, copy of passport and 3 passport size photographs are to be reached the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

- All certificates must be duly attested. By the competent authority, i.e. Education Board, the Foreign Ministries of the respective countries and respective Bangladesh Missions abroad.
- Successful applicants have to produce all academic certificates, admit cards and mark- sheets/ transcripts in original at the time of their admission.
- **3. Tuition Fee:** As Per College Rules.
- **4. Application Fee:** As Per College Rules.



Undertaking in the form of Bond

The candidates and their parents or guardians are required to sign bonds on non-judicial stamp papers regarding the terms and conditions of the code of conduct and disciplines during the tenure of MBBS course.

Conduct and Discipline

- Students must maintain strict discipline in the college. On disciplinary grounds the following penalties may be imposed on a student, depending on nature of the offence:
 - 01. Warning
 - 02. Fines
 - 03. Expulsion from the College, temporarily or permanent
 - 04. Any other as decided by the college academic council
- A student's name may be removed from the College Register under the following circumstances:
 - 01. Remaining absent from classes for consecutive two months without any information. The student needs to take re-admission in such condition.
 - 02. Disciplinary ground, on the advice of the Academic Council.
 - 03. Non-payment of college dues for consecutive three months for the due date of payment.

Rules and Regulations for Students

- Students have to carry their "Identity cards" when in the college and in the hospital.
- 2. Students must be well dressed, clean & attend the classes with white aprons.
- 3. Fashionable dress, cosmetics, untidy hair, slippers are prohibited in the campus. Male students must wear shoes in the campus. Female students must tie their hairs properly.
- 4. Rings, bangles etc. are not allowed in the practical classes.
- 5. Green Life Medical College is a non-smoking zone.
- 6. Environment should be kept clean. Students are requested to throw solid waste/litter into waste bins.
- 7. Sticking of posters on the walls of the college and the hospital premises are prohibited. These are considered as acts of indiscipline and the offenders involved are liable to punishment.
- All types of agitation, processions, shouting in the college and hospital premises are prohibited and students involved in those activities are liable to be expelled from college.
- Absence from classes individually or in a mass without prior information and without valid reasons are punishable.
- 10. Students will state their problems/grievances/inconveniences to their respective departmental teachers/Mentor. The Mentor will solve the problems of the students or refer them to the Head of the department.
- 11. Students must not misbehave with the staff or employees of the college. Misbehavior is an act of indiscipline and liable for punishment.



- 12. Students are expected to maintain the highest standard in their academic and private lives. Loss of moral and spiritual values or addiction to alcohol and narcotic drugs are punishable offence.
- 13. Text books, dissecting instruments or necessary equipments will not be provided by the college.
- 14. Leave: In case of illness or other unavoidable reasons of non-attendance, a written application from the student should be presented to the Head of the department.
- 15. Receiving private coaching from any teacher of Green Life Medical College is prohibited. If any student or his/her guardian seeks private coaching from any teacher of this institution and if it be proved, he/she (student) may face dismissal from studentship/ expulsion from the examination or from college register.
- 16. Cost of loss/damage to college/hospital property is liable to be realized from the student who is found responsible for the loss/ damage of the college/hospital property.
- 17. Political activities are strictly prohibited in the college.
- 18. Use of any kind of smart phone or laptop/tablet computer is prohibited in the classrooms and campus. All above rules & regulations can be modified by the Academic Council and Governing Body.

Information for the Parents/Guardians:

- There are four professional examinations in MBBS Curriculum. There are two sessions of Professional MBBS Examination in a year, i.e. in May and November.
- Parents should look after the student whether they are attending their classes, item exams, term exams, as they are required to complete and pass all term exams. Seventy five percent (75%) class attendance is required to be eligible for the each professional examination.
- The tuition fee per month should be paid within the first week of every month. Failure of payment within due date is liable to pay a late fee per day along with the dues. For delay in payment for more then one month the name of the particular student will be removed from the Attendance Register. The name of the student will be removed from the College Register if the payment is not given for three months consecutively.
- 4. After successfully passing final professional MBBS examination, students have to complete one year Internship Training in Green Life Medical College Hospital to get registration from Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council (BMDC).

Accommodation facilities

GMC has separate accommodation facilities for boys and girls. The rooms are comprising of double bed and triple bed. The accommodation facilities will be provided to all applicants. However, seats are reserved for all foreign students.



Green Life Medical College Hospital

Green Life Medical College Hospital is a best in class medical service center with 550 beds that started its journey in 2005. It offers special and super specialty services, including diagnostic facilities to ensure the delivery of holistic patient care. The hospital is staffed with dedicated and trained personnel who work with sophisticated and most advanced equipments.

Green Life Medical College Hospital has fully equipped department including 24 hours Emergency services, Radiology and Imaging, Dialysis unit, Chemotherapy center, Intensive care unit (ICU) with 20 beds, NICU, HDU, Neuro-care Unit, Joint replacement surgery, Arthroscopy and Arthroscopic surgery, Hand surgery, Laparoscopic surgery, facilities of Endoscopy, Colonoscopy, ERCP and ESWL, a Physiotherapy center and a Rheumatology Research Centre. A newly built well-equipped Cardiology unit including CCU, Cathlab and Operation Theatre are fully functional.

The Operation Theatre of GMCH is the state-of-the-art complex with 7 hi-tech Operation Theatres with Laminar Air Flow, Recovery room and Delivery room. The outpatient departments can serve up to 800 patients per day. Besides, free medical service is provided to a good number of poor and needy patients. Diploma, B.Sc and Post-basic B.Sc. passed nurses are working in the hospital.

Number of hospital beds, specialized units and investigation facilities will increase immediately after the college shifts to the newly build academic building. There is plan for further expansion of the hospital in adjacent buildings.

GMCH at the time of pandemic

Since March 2020, news about the Corona virus disease (COVID-19) pandemic have made many of the people of Bangladesh feel perplexed about going to the emergency of a hospital or getting medical care, and have wondered if it is safe to go to the hospital. It is found out that nearly 40% of people were avoiding or delaying medical care due to COVID-19 concerns. Emergency departments of some hospitals had about half their usual number of patients.

Green Life Hospital, its ICU and its emergency department as a whole took precautions to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus and help make sure that visits to the emergency and hospital are as safe as possible, following strict guidelines for protecting people during the COVID-19 pandemic. These included universal masking requiring that everyone wears a face mask; screening and hand washing at all entrances of GMCH for COVID-19 signs and symptoms; separate waiting areas for people who have or may have COVID-19 in designated areas of the Emergency department away from those who don't have COVID-19 signs and symptoms; frequent cleaning and disinfecting of the waiting areas, rooms, restrooms and surfaces to accommodate updated COVID-19 hospital cleaning protocols and social distancing in check-in and waiting areas in Emergency Department and as a whole in the hospital. GMCH has kept 130 general beds and 12 beds ICU dedicated for the COVID-19 patients.

GMCH has provided treatment to a large number of COVID-19 patients successfully till April 2021. The mortality rate at the hospital was one of the lowest amongst the non-government facilities. The Hospital is continuing to treat both the Corona virus positive and negative patients at full swing by maintaining strict triage system at the OPD and emergency department.



Green Life College of Nursing

Green Life College of Nursing (GCN) came into existence in 2009. This College (GCN) is approved by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MOHFW), Government of Bangladesh and Bangladesh Nursing & Midwifery Council (BNMC) and affiliated to the University of Dhaka (DU).

The college commences its activities with the enrollment with 3 Courses.

- 01. Diploma in Nursing Science & Midwifery (03 Years)
- 02. Basic B.Sc in Nursing (04 Years)
- 03. Post Basic B.Sc in Nursing (02 Years)

Since inception, the college has undergone tremendous development and became a splendid centre for learning and development. At present we are enrolling 140 students each year.

We continue to evaluate and improve our program to ensure the best nursing education for the students. Our educational strategy is to create a conducive learning environment and to steer our students to acquire adequate knowledge, skills and temperament to practice medicine and be a competent health care professional group.
